<b>Scope of work</b>	<p>To monitor, comment and advise AIPPI on policy and legal frameworks relating to copyrights and related (neighbouring) rights, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• review of policy initiatives and proposed legislative changes;</li> <li>• review of judicial decisions;</li> <li>• monitoring of the copyright related agenda and work of (1) WIPO and (2) other organisations with a focus on (among other things) copyrights.</li> </ul> <p>(the <i>Field</i>).</p> <p>To advise the Bureau of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• developments in the Field meriting an AIPPI position, including any further study or analysis necessary or desirable to determine an AIPPI position;</li> <li>• possible avenues for cooperation with GOs and other NGOs in the Field.</li> </ul> <p>To identify, select and provide to the Bureau key documentation relevant to the Field.<sup>1</sup></p> <p>To serve as a resource for AIPPI when positions relevant to the Field are conveyed by AIPPI, including, in the absence of an existing AIPPI position, to formulate a position if requested by the Bureau.</p>
